Please <u>DO NOT</u> put your name on the paragraph. (If the student wants the paragraph back, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope.)
- The award will be made directly to the camp the student wishes to attend. (If all fees have already been paid, the student will provide proof of registration to GFMTA.)
- The application, application fee (\$5), recording, and paragraph must be submitted by the deadline.

Scholarship Application Guidelines

The members of Great Falls Music Teachers have made a commitment to insure academic growth of music students. We strive make continuing education available to those who wish to pursue musical excellence in their music study by offering scholarships to encourage this musical development.

Please follow these guidelines when applying for a scholarship for workshop, institute or convention:

- a. The student must be currently taking private lesson on their instrument or voice.
- b. The student must submit a written recommendation from their private teacher.
- c. The student must be registered for the workshop, institute or convention they plan to attend.
- d. The student must perform 2 contrasting pieces (not to exceed 10 minutes) on a recording.
- e. Application fee is \$5.00 and is submitted with the application.

The award will be sent directly to the workshop by the treasurer of GFMTA.

The adjudicator(s) will either be an outside member of GFMTA or a minimum of 3 committee members of GFMTA.

If a committee member has a relative or student applying for scholarship, the member shall abstain from voting on the scholarship for which the relative or student is applying.

Deadlines for application shall be strictly enforced and shall be set up yearly by the GFMTA scholarship committee.

Application form and recording must be sent to scholarship chairperson on or before application deadline written on application form.
